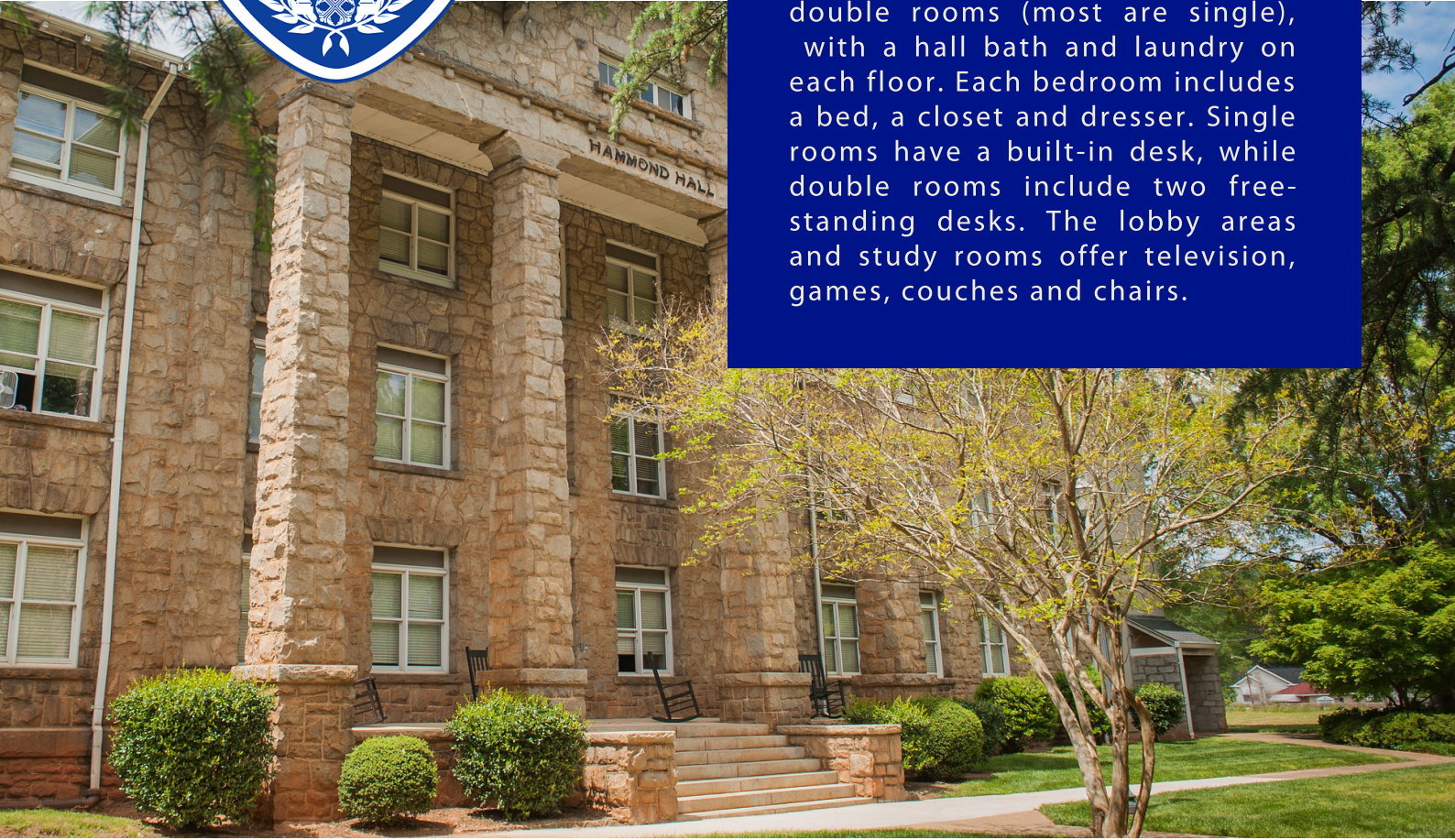




# HAMMOND HALL

Hammond Hall, the first building ever built on campus, is a coed residence hall, with floors split by gender. It has both single and double rooms (most are single), with a hall bath and laundry on each floor. Each bedroom includes a bed, a closet and dresser. Single rooms have a built-in desk, while double rooms include two free-standing desks. The lobby areas and study rooms offer television, games, couches and chairs.



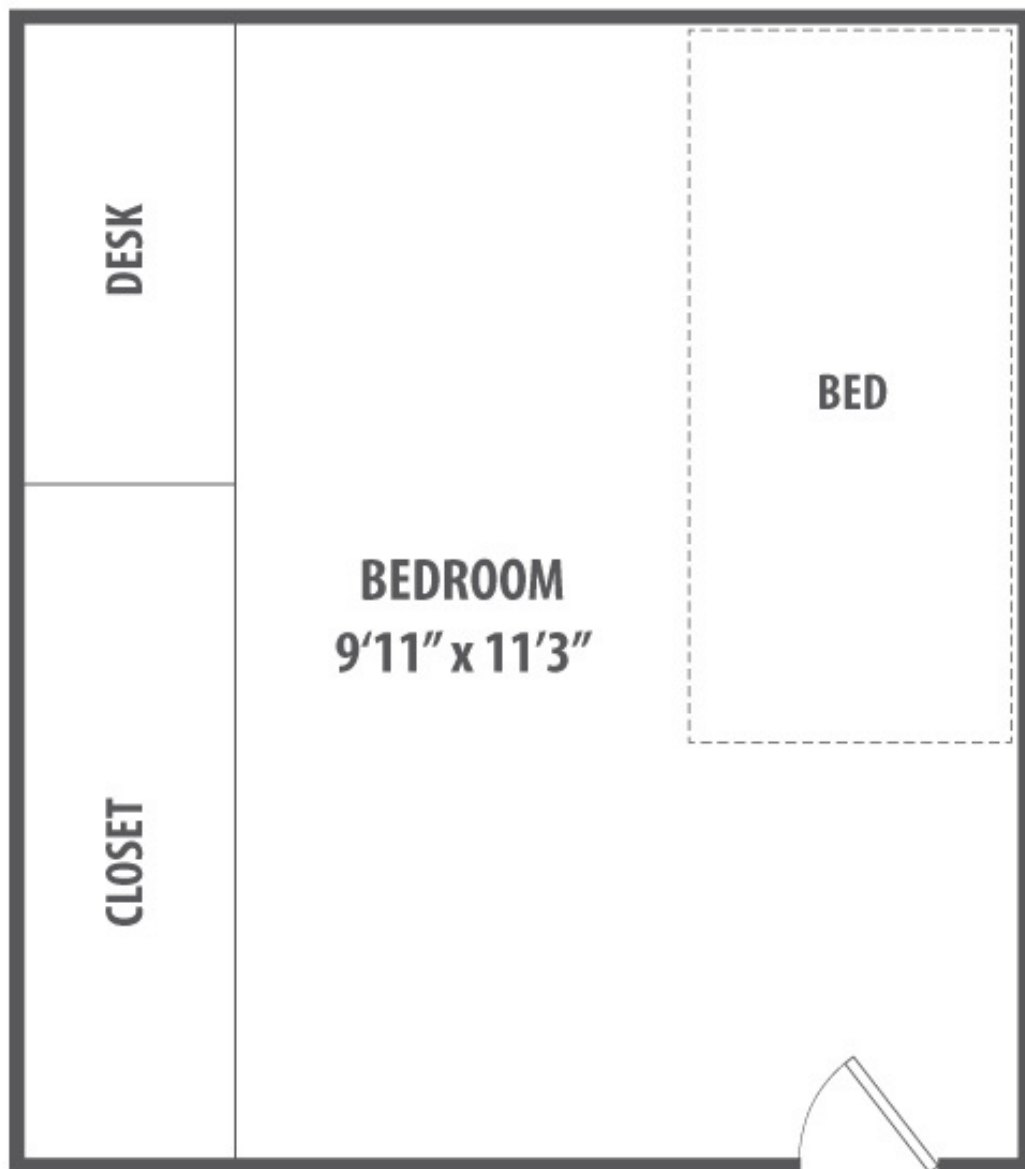
## Hammond Hall Features:

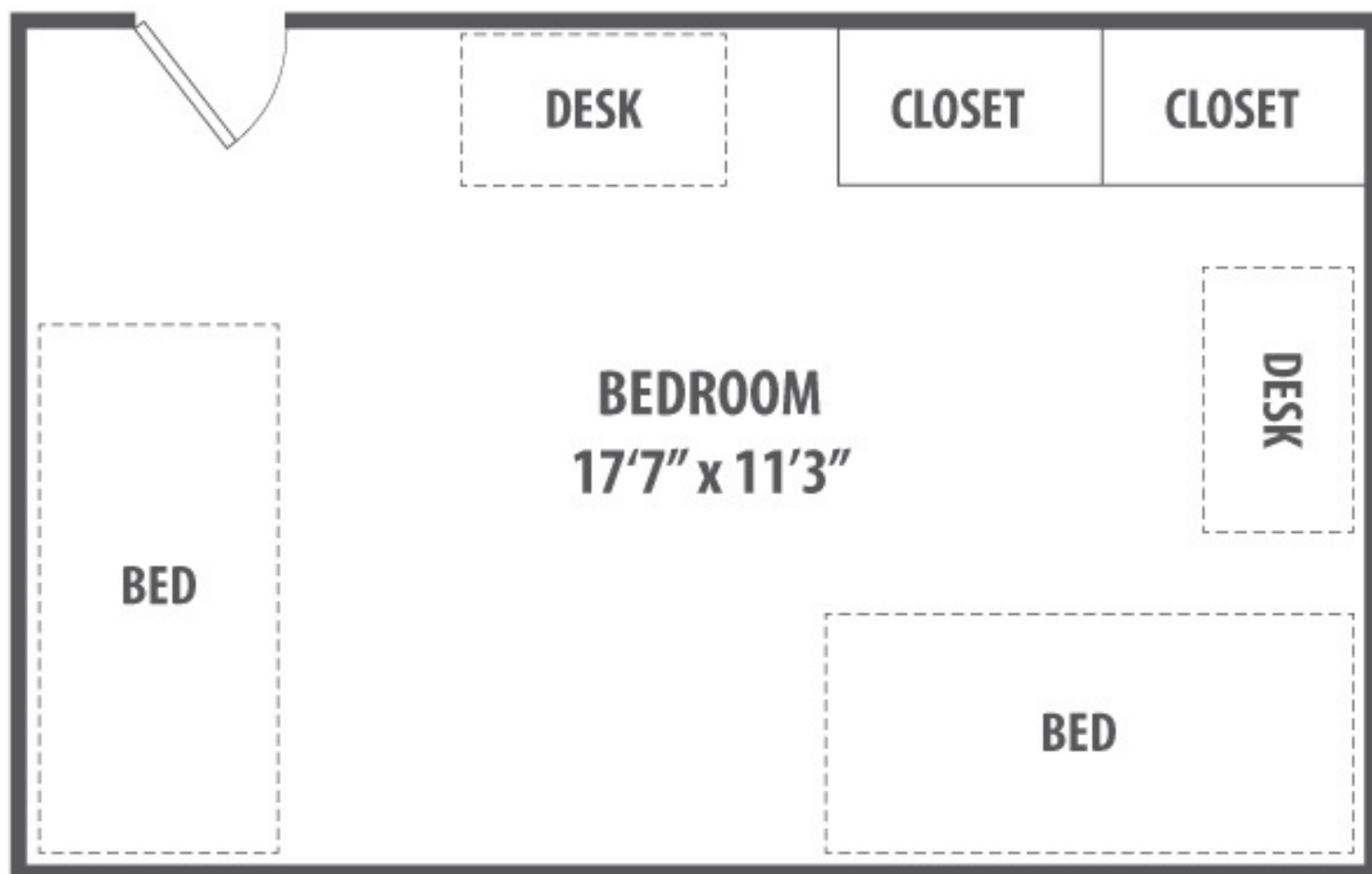
- Built-in Desk: 53"W x 24"D
