## Student Retention

Fall-to-fall retention data measure the percent of first-time freshmen and first-time transfers who return to the college for a second year following their initial enrollment. These numbers are based on fall enrollment.

## Graduation, Transfer-Out Rate

Graduation rate is an IPEDS reported figure. The cohort is based on all entering first-time full-time freshmen, with exceptions allowed for deceased, military and certain civil and religious exclusions. Graduation rate is measured after $150 \%$ of program length, which in the case of SMC, is now six years. (Students entering in FA2021 will be counted as positive if they graduate by the end of summer 2027.)

Since SMC's mission includes transfer, the transfer-out rate for the same cohort is also reported. The total graduates plus transfer-out within $150 \%$ of program length is counted as the college's Success Rate.
